Choose the correct answer from the given four options:

Question 2:

While computing mean of grouped data, we assume that the frequencies are

- (A) evenly distributed over all the classes
- (B) centered at the class marks of the classes
- (C) centered at the upper limits of the classes
- (D) centered at the lower of the classes

Answer 2:

- (B) centered at the class marks of the classes

Solution:

In computing the mean of grouped data, the frequencies are centered at the class marks of the classes.

Hence, the option (B) is correct.
